Thanks to your faithfulness in giving we have been able to survive up to this point. However, things are very crucial right now. We were able to get the second story built for the school at the Kyona property. We have space for classrooms. The rooms are built and have a concrete roof over them. We now need to do the finishing work on the concrete blocks so there will be a smooth surface to be able to paint. We have two more rooms to build on the ground level for our little ones in the kindergarten classes. We need to build the railing for the stairs out of iron. We need to replace our weary old benches, which have definitely seen better days. We need new chalkboards for each classroom. We need a desk and chair for the office and two new 4 drawer filing cabinets. There is work to be done to finish fencing the area closing the play area. We need to build another toilet with showers for the school and for our workers living on site.

School just closed for the summer vacation and will reopen in September, Lord willing. We have a short amount of time to get a lot of work done. **WE CAN NOT DO IT WITHOUT YOU!!!** We don't want to keep putting Covid in everything but it has made it very difficult for us to schedule camps, VBS and church speaking dates in the U.S. for this summer, 2021, because there were so many unknowns. Usually, by the first of June the kids and I would already be in the states and would have had a couple of camps and three or four churches already behind us. We desperately need a break; it has been quite a year. We need to be Stateside just to get ourselves back into shape to keep going. We need to go to the doctor and the dentist. We need to be with some family and friends and just relax.

Here it is, in a nutshell:

- **Will you and your church family do something special to help us accomplish all of this?**
- **Will you take a special offering? or even more than one?**
- **Will you use us for camp or VBS even though we can't be there?**
- **Will you make a personal sacrifice that would help us get ourselves refreshed and renewed and send us back to Haiti to get things ready for school to open? (ex. one less meal out this week, one month without Starbucks, watch a movie at home instead of going to the theater)**

The doors are still open for us to serve the Lord in Haiti in spite of all the turmoil. We are free to share His word right in the classroom; in fact, it's part of our curriculum! We feel like God wants us to be in Haiti doing just that. Lots of changes have happened in Haiti. We have had to be beyond flexible to bend and change with it and not break. These changes have brought us to one central location. It has been rough on our community and on our family. People have become scattered and even homeless, not even able to live in their homes in Carries. God helped Wilckly to see clearly that we couldn't put all of our eggs in one basket. The people, about 30 of our own, including Bioude, were able to take refuge at the property where we lived and received our groups. This made it very crowded. Wilckly and I and the kids moved to the farm property at Kyona where we are currently living. This year school had to be done in less than appropriate make-shift facilities. We want to be able to change all that.

God, through you, has provided for our ministry. We believe He will continue to provide through you for the Kindergarten - 9th grade school, vocational school, and Bible school to be completed and to continue training those who come through its doors for years to come. We are praying for a better future for Haiti. We are praying with our positive, hopeful, faithful and tireless efforts, together with your prayers and financial help we will continue to make changes for the better in Haiti, as we, of Blessing Hearts International, keep changing lives, touching hearts, sharing Christ, reaching the world, one soul at a time.
