Churches are angry that they are being told not to meet, our school children have now missed a total of five months of school this year, not to mention most of last year, and random roadblocks are still happening, some very close to us.

Please pray for our hearts and minds right now. Pray for our physical health and safety, yes, but mostly we ask you to go to war on our behalf in prayer for our emotional and spiritual health. Living this way for two years is exhausting. Even the kids notice a difference in "the Haiti we used to know" and now, and they are longing just like us for the freedom we once had to travel around and do ministry.
