So many things to be thankful for of late:


- Wilckly receiving his green card and official approval as U.S. Resident...

Mami Simone was our hired chef from almost the moment we set foot in Carries. She came from a local restaurant, and there was nowhere else in Haiti we could go and find food that tasted as delicious as hers. Though cooking for 75-100 people everyday took a pretty big team, she gave the final touch to nearly every dish. She was such a hard worker, washing and slicing and prepping and cooking for hours in the broiling hot kitchen. Once a visiting team came and installed ceiling fans in all our rooms, but Mami Simone refused to turn the kitchen unit on because the breeze tampered with the flame on the stove and thus what she was cooking!

Mami Simone's talent and work ethic was only part of her appeal, though... she had the sweetest smile and the most adorable laugh. She loved the kids and was always ready to let one of us taste what she was making. She knew each of our favorite dishes and loved surprising us with them. When she passed away last month she left another hole in

our hearts...Haiti simply will not be the same without her.
