


Blessing Hearts MINISTRIES

Wilckly has finally received his green card!!! We feel as though we want to just type and say that over and over. We know God has had a purpose in keeping us here in the U.S. for this season, though at times it was so hard to understand that purpose and to "wait well". This season has been a challenging lesson in several areas:

 Rest. Though culturally in Haiti the pursuit of rest is taken quite seriously and treated with respect, with the endless demands and requests for aid we are often on the go and at-the-ready. Though we have been helping as we can from afar (Wilckly is constantly on the



phone with our people on the ground there), so much of this season has been spent sitting back and encouraging others to take the lead in our absence. We have had to learn to let go of a lot and trust God to work for us.

2. Truth. We KNOW that God's faithfulness in forgiving us of our sin and rescuing us from its consequence is of ultimate importance...but in the every-day struggles of waiting on His timing for earthly matters it can be difficult to apply that to our thoughts and feelings. Clinging to His faithfulness, love, and the hope He gives in the most vital aspect of this

life (our salvation) helps us to remember His faithfulness in the smaller things, too, and that He always has our best and His ultimate glory in mind.

We are thankful for all He has been teaching us, and that He continues to entrust us with this ministry in Haiti and now expanding to the Dominican

Republic. We are INCREDIBLY thankful for all of YOU and your support and prayers as we have navigated this season and the difficulties and many blessings it has brought. We are SO thankful for the time this season of waiting and sitting has allowed for us to spend with all of YOU in person, and have been SO encouraged and uplifted by each and every one of you. This is truly a partnership and the ministry could not go on without YOU.

Future Plans:

Now that Wilckly's U.S. residency is official, he is free to travel outside the U.S.. God's people have already provided ticket money and he will be booking tickets for a survey trip. His goals are to:

1. Secure housing near the land we have bought, for he and Dee when they are there, and for receiving groups when they come to visit.

2. Develop a good relationship and communication with the neighborhood community and assess the need to establish a church in the area.

3. Assess the need for a Spanish speaking service and a Creole speaking service.

4. Assess the need for creating sustainable jobs.

5. Assess needed supplies to bring when returning with Dee.

Please pray for Dee's passport to be processed quickly so she can join him on the second trip and assess things also.
