Thank you so much for your prayers as Dee recovers from her second knee surgery. She is recovering well, and is so excited to be able to plan going back with Wilckly to the Dominican Republic in September! Please continue to pray for her recovery and Wilckly's health.

The kids are doing well: Ashley lives in Florida but was able to go north to Iowa for a little while to help Dee after her surgery. Kelsey continues her work as a CNA at the nursing home in Bedford and is also a temporary PARA at the high-school for a new Haitian JH student who needs help adjusting linguistically. Josiah is in 10th grade and loving baseball and football, of which both teams got to go to state this past year!

Wilckly continues to lead, guide and disciple from across the sea. We recently lost another deacon at one of our churches in Haiti, which left the congregation with no leader on-site, so he has been helping them over the phone to make wise decisions in this area.



La Saline, one of the first churches Wilckly planted that was mentioned in our last letter, is celebrating their 32nd anniversary this month with a four-week long revival! We praise God for their perseverance (they exist right in the heart of some of the greatest upheaval and violence in Port-au-Prince) and fervor. This church has been so fruitful for the Kingdom!

Many of you remember, I'm sure, when we asked for help getting Jhemson (the very first baby raised in the Berea Children's Home, and the reason it was started) across the border to be with Wilckly in the D.R. Due to very generous donations we are now financially able to move him, but there were many safety concerns, so currently he is still in Haiti. Once we are back there in the D.R. we are planning, Lord willing, to make the move to get him across. Please pray for open doors, wisdom on our parts, and especially safety for him and his travel companion as we strive to get him somewhere he can receive the best care possible.
